

Of children feel more connected to friends thanks to their smartphones.*





Net Children Go Mobile: risks and opportunities.

While teenagers are almost twice as likely to think of smartphones as tools that facilitate a stronger connection with the peer group, both children aged 9-12 and teenagers aged 13-16 associate smartphones with the pressure to be 'always on'.

The 50% of children reported feeling a 'strong need' to check their phones to see if anything new has happened.
